

Letters Patent to Holgate - dated 26th June 32 year of Henry 8th

Price £276 - Purchase the whole house and site of the late Priory of Malton, and the whole Church, Belfry, and Church-yard of the same late Priory, and all Messuages etc within the site, Sept ambit circuit and precinct of the same late Priory, and all our two small crofts of land called Toller Croft, and the Cotegarh, and 24 Oxfangs - demesne lands of the said Priory - Sutton Grange in the Parish of Norton - Brome Close or Brome Hill in the Parish of Kirby over Ka - Annual fee to the King £1.10s.8d. - also the whole Fishery in the Water of Darewent.

Archbishop Holgate's Will was proved Dec 4th 1556 in the Prerogative Court Canterbury, entered in a book called "Kitchen". John Broxholme and Thomas Spencer Executors.

The site, precinct and demesne lands of Yeddingham were by his Will left to found an Hospital at Hemsworth "Carlisle's Charities".
