## THE TEMPEST - A Summary

Prospero, a magician and rightful Duke of Milan, has been cast upon an island with his daughter, Miranda. He is served by Ariel, a spirit, and Caliban, a deformed savage.

By his magic, Prospero has caused a ship containing his brother, Anthonio, the usurping Duke of Milan, and Alonso, the King of Naples, to be wrecked off the shore of the island. Ferdinand, Alonso's son, separated from the Royal Party, meets Miranda with whom he falls in love.

Prospero, by means of his magic art, reveals to Anthonio and Alonso the realisation of their misdeeds, and final reconciliation is brought about in the betrothal of the young couple.
